School Grounds

By Monday we anticipate that all work on the school grounds to improve safety and security will be completed. This will mean that there is:

- A designated parking area for staff only and the school buses at the beginning and end of the day. This should ensure more parking space for parents outside the school grounds.
- A playground area for the pupils which is larger than before.
- Repositioned play equipment to be used during school hours only.
- No longer pupil access to unlocked exits during the school day.

School responsibility:

To ensure pupils are safe during the school day within the school grounds and that the school grounds are secure.

Parental responsibility:

To ensure your child is brought safely to and from school (via the school gate). This is regardless of whether you are walking or driving.

Parking is your responsibility, not the responsibility of the school. There are parents double parking right by the school entrance, causing chaos and danger to themselves and others. If you choose to park in this manner, you are accountable. We recommend you park away from the entrance and walk up to the school. The amount of on-street parking outside school has not changed.

Thank you for your understanding and co-operation in this matter. The safety of pupils, parents, staff and visitors whilst on the school grounds is paramount. Unlike most schools we do not have high perimeter fencing or security cameras and we would like to keep it this way.

PLEASE NOTE

Teachers will wait by the green gate with your child if you are running late for afternoon pickup.

However, anyone arriving at school from 3.30pm onwards will need to collect their child from the main reception area.

This also applies to pick up from clubs and Breakfast/Sunset Club.

As previously, pupils should not be riding scooters or bikes on the school grounds.
