## Year 3/4/5 Olympic Challenge Friday 1st July 2016

Our Topic this term is 'Road To Rio', looking forward to the 2016 Olympics. As part of our studies we are going to Edmond Hall near Newport, Shropshire on Friday 1st July to take part in a range of events modelled on the games. This will be a day of light hearted activity with a focus on Olympic values. The children will experience an opening ceremony, a range of slightly competitive activities, award ceremonies and a look at the pledges made by both the competitors and the referees.

The children should wear a PE kit and bring suitable outdoor clothing, eg long trousers and long sleeved tops/fleeces. The organisers have advised that wellies or old trainers are a must.

The children will also need the following:

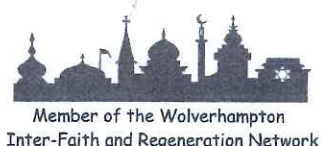
- a packed lunch and water bottle;
- sunscreen and sun hat;
- a light rain coat in case of bad weather;
- if the weather is looking showery, a change of clothes will be needed.

Please ensure everything you send is clearly labelled with your child's name.

Can I also remind all children to ensure that any inhalers are in school. Any child we have registered as asthmatic must take an inhaler with them.

The cost of the trip is £17.00 per child (payable via ParentPay by Monday 27th June). Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1998, we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made. However, the visits can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
